



Exhibition of Paintings in Kanturk Library by Adults - Guidelines

Who? The exhibition is open to adults living in the greater Kanturk area

Where? It will be held in Kanturk Library

What? Works to be exhibited may include painting, drawing and hand-made print. There is no restriction of theme or subject.

When? The exhibition will open on March 13th and run until March 17th.

How?

- Bring one, or a maximum of two works to the library before March 2nd 2010.
- All works on paper must be suitably framed.
- Paintings on canvas stretchers may be presented without frames, if so wished.
- *All works* must be properly presented for exhibition; *labelled* (see below), *strung*, and ready for hanging.
- *Outside* dimensions of works along their longest side (incl. frame) should not exceed:
 - 30 inches (76cm.) in the case of a single work; 18 inches (46cm) where two works are to be exhibited.
- A label bearing the following information must be affixed to the work(s):
 - Name (and contact details if work is for sale)
 - Title of work
 - Medium
 - (Price if applicable)
- There will be no selection process (unless numbers are unexpectedly high), so participants are requested to bring only works which are in their opinion, their strongest. It is important to demonstrate the high-level of visual skills that exist around Kanturk.
- Although there is no set theme for the exhibition, participants are encouraged to consider their locality as a possible starting point.
