

## Open Exhibition in Kanturk Library 2013 Invitation and Guidelines

Who? The exhibition is open to adults living in the greater Kanturk area

Where? It will be held in Kanturk Library

When? The exhibition will open on March 15th and run until March 20th.

**What?** Works to be exhibited may include painting, drawing and hand-made print. There is no restriction of theme or subject. The festival is holding a separate photographic exhibition

## How?

- Submit one, or a maximum of two <u>previously un-exhibited</u> works to Jo's Boutique, Strand St., before March 14<sup>th</sup>.
- All works on paper must be suitably framed. Paintings on canvas stretchers may be presented without frames, if so wished.
- All works must be properly presented for exhibition; <u>labelled</u> (N.B. see below), <u>strung</u>, and <u>ready for hanging</u>.
- A label bearing the following information <u>must</u> be affixed to the work(s):
  - Artist's Name (and contact details if work is for sale)
  - Title of work
  - Medium
  - Price (if applicable)
- Previously-submitted works should not be again submitted.
- There will be no selection process (unless numbers are unexpectedly high), so
  participants are requested to bring only works which are in their opinion, their
  strongest.
- Please contact the curator if you wish to submit extra-large work.
- Exhibitors are requested to leave work hanging until the close of the exhibition and it can be collected from Jo's Boutique, Strand St, from March 21<sup>st</sup> onwards.
